WHY COMMUNITY HEALTH CARE?

Community Health Care is a nonprofit organization created in 1969 in Tacoma, WA to serve the uninsured and under-insured in Pierce County.

Community Health Care is a Federally Qualified Health Center and part of the nation's health care safety net. Five percent of patients are under 200% of the federal poverty level. It consists of a network of 6 medical and 4 dental clinics in addition to 6 full-service pharmacies.

In 2021, **Community Health Care** provided care to 46,337 patients through 163,529 visits. 461 babies were delivered under care of our providers. 7,271 patients (15.6% of the total) were served in a language other than English.



WE LOVE THE PNW!

In the heart of the Pacific Northwest, Tacoma is a vibrant center for culture, restaurants, art, museums, music and home to three major universities. Nestled between two mountain ranges and situated on the shoreline of the pristine Puget Sound, Tacoma is an outdoor lover's paradise - just minutes away from sailing, hiking, biking, fishing, skiing, and more. Tacoma is centrally located, just 30 minutes south of Seattle.

INTER-DISCIPLINARY RESIDENCY

Community Health Care has responded to the overwhelming need for Primary care providers at all levels of training by developing one of the nation's first inter-disciplinary resident program. MD and DO residents will learn alongside trainee nurse practitioners, physician assistants, as well as dentists and pharmacists. **Community Health Care's** residency aims to equip providers with tools necessary to care for a diverse population with complex medical and dental needs.



FAMILY MEDICINE RESIDENCY

Community Health Care is a full-spectrum dually accredited residency program. We are a clinic-based program with training located at a new state-of-art-building. Our focus is to provide the volume and intensity of clinical training necessary for family physicians serving in the complex setting of the country's health care safety net.

TRAINING LOCATIONS

Education consists of a continuity clinic at **Community Health Care's** Hilltop Regional health Center, other **Community Health Care clinics**, and 3 local hospitals (including a pediatric hospital). The residency is affiliated with Virginia Mason Franciscan Health System and Multicare Health System, both of which operate the area's hospitals. There is also an association with the University of Washington, known for its excellence in primary care training.

Community Health Care's Hilltop Regional Health Center is home to the residency program and has dedicated an entire floor to residency offices, exam rooms, and education enrichment rooms.
